**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA,
AMENDING THE "CARNEGIE TOWN CODE" BY
ADDING SUBSECTION G, SECTION 5-7B-2, ARTICLE B,
CHAPTER 7 OF SAID CODE; BY PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF
CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1.

The "Carnegie Town Code" is hereby amended by adding Subsection G, Section 5-7B-2, Article B, Chapter 7 to said code which subsection shall read as follows:

G. Animal Control Policy: All animals picked up by the Town of Carnegie Animal Control Officer will be housed at the Town of Carnegie Animal Shelter for three days. At the end of this three day period, any animal that is not claimed will either be put up for adoption or euthanized.

Before any animal may be claimed, a pet license must be obtained at the Town Hall. No license will be issued without proof of vaccinations. If an animal is picked up a second time an animal at large fee of \$40.00 will be charged. This must be paid prior to the release of the animal. If this same animal is picked up a third time, the price will be \$80.00. On the fourth offense the animal may be put up for adoption or euthanized without notice given to the owner.

All animals are to be licensed with the Town of Carnegie, and they must have current vaccination records. These may include a receipt from a licensed veterinarian or a documented record that the owner has given these vaccines themselves and may be held liable. The license fee for females that have not been spayed or males that have not been neutered is \$7.50 per year. All others are licensed at a price of \$5.00 per year. These licenses are due annually and it is the responsibility of the owner to see to it that these are taken care of in a timely manner.

If an animal does not have a current vaccination record, they may be released with a deposit of \$100.00, which will be refunded once proof of vaccination is received.

If an individual is missing an animal that they believe to be held at the Town Shelter, they may call City Hall, 580-654-1004, and leave a message with a detailed description of their missing pet.

An adoption fee of \$5.00 per day, for each day that the animal has been housed at the Animal Shelter will be charged to any individual wishing to adopt an animal from the animal shelter or adoption agency.


SECTION 2.

All ordinances, resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE
