ORDINANCE NO. 236

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA,
ADOPTING THE 2005 "CARNEGIE TOWN CODE";
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. Adoption of 2005 "Carnegie Town Code".

The 2005 "Carnegie Town Code" is hereby adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Carnegie, Oklahoma, in its entirety, and same is hereby declared to be and shall hereinafter constitute the official town code of Carnegie, Oklahoma, and shall hereinafter be known and cited as the Carnegie Town Code and that same shall be filed and notification of publication of said code shall be as provided for by companion Resolution No. 2005-8 approved in connection herewith.

SECTION 2.

An immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting, as required by law.
