**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA  
AMENDING SECTION 8-4-5, CHAPTER 4,  
OF THE "CARNEGIE TOWN CODE";  
PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie, Oklahoma:

Section 8-4-5, Chapter 4 of the "Carnegie Town Code" is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

Subsection A. of Section 8-4-5, Chapter 4, shall be replaced by the following, to-wit:



**A. Regulations for the use of polycarts (if available):**

1. All residents will be required to use polycarts if on an established polycart pickup route. No trash will be picked up that is placed in cans, barrels or on the ground.
2. Each such residence will be supplied with a numbered polycart that will be registered to them with no deposit required.
3. Residents on an established polycart route wishing to have more than one polycart will be required to place a \$50.00 deposit for each extra cart, unless they have been established at that residence for more than 5 years. They will be charged an extra \$10.00 per month for the extra pick up.
4. Anyone who moves into town after this policy is in effect will be required to put up a \$50.00 deposit for each polycart they request. This deposit is in addition to the standard meter deposit that is already required. This polycart deposit will be refunded if the bill is paid in full and the polycart is in reusable condition when services are terminated, or if customer has resided at the same address for at least one (1) year with no violations of the contract.
5. Anyone whose services are disconnected for non-payment will have their polycart picked up and sanitation services will not be provided until the bill is paid in full. A \$50.00 deposit will be required at that time if there is not one already in place.
6. Residents who transfer from one location to another will have their numbered polycart moved with them to the new location.
7. Residents are responsible for the safety and upkeep of the polycart. If it is lost or stolen, the resident will be required to pay the full replacement price for their polycart and a \$50.00 deposit will be required, if one is not already in place.
8. Trash must be bagged unless it is boxes, or other dry items.
9. Household trash only. No limbs, leaves, chemicals, paint, batteries, metal objects or construction materials will be picked up.
10. Polycarts are to be placed on the curb in front of the residence or at any other place established by the sanitation crew.

SECTION 2.

Subsection A., as previously numbered, shall be renumbered as Subsection B., and shall be amended to read as follows:

- B. Receptacles Required: The owner or occupant, as the case may be, of any and all premises in the town not on an established polycart pickup route and not subject to the provisions of Subsection A. above shall procure, supply and place up to four (4) watertight, plastic or other lightweight cans that must be of sufficient size to hold not more than thirty three (33) gallons, with close fitting covers and rack for said cans, except that no rack shall be required for curbside pick up.

SECTION 3.

Subsections B.-F., as previously numbered, shall be renumbered as Subsections C.-G.


SECTION 4.


All ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
