**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA,
AMENDING SECTION 5-4-1, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 5
OF THE "CARNEGIE TOWN CODE";
PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie,
Oklahoma:**

**SECTION 5-4-1, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 5 of the "Carnegie Town Code" is hereby
amended as follows:**

SECTION 1. Subsection A. of Section 5-4-1, shall be amended as follows, to-wit:

5-4-1 FIREWORKS; SALE, POSSESSION OR DISCHARGE

A. Possession And Discharge: It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person, firm or corporation to possess, discharge, ignite or in any manner aid, assist or abet in the discharging or igniting of any firecrackers of any size, type or description, skyrockets, pistols, torpedoes, Roman candles, flash salutes, flash crackers, balloons or other fireworks or substances designed and intended for pyrotechnic display, or small display ground pieces, canes, cap pistols, cannons or other appliances using caps containing chlorate or potash mixture, within the corporate limits of the town, except on July 4, between the hours of five o'clock (5:00) P.M. and eleven o'clock (11:00) P.M.

SECTION 2.

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE

An immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting, as required by law.
