

ORDINANCE #248

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA, ADDING SECTION 5-7-3(F.)(3.), CHAPTER 7, TITLE 5 OF THE "CARNEGIE TOWN CODE"; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. Section 5-7-3(F.)(3.), Chapter 7, Title 5 of the "Carnegie Town Code", is hereby added and will read as follows, to-wit:

5-7-3 REGULATIONS FOR KEEPING CERTAIN ANIMALS:

F. Livestock And Fowl:

3. While the keeping of horses consistent with the requirements of subsections (F.)(1.) and (F.)(2.) above shall be permitted it shall be unlawful and an offense for any person to ride horses upon any sidewalk within the municipal limits or in designated areas of the Town Park.


SECTION 2.


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
