

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING SECTION 1-9-23, CHAPTER 9 TITLE 1 OF THE "CARNEGIE TOWN CODE"; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie, Oklahoma:

Section 1-9-23, Chapter 9, Title 1 of the "Carnegie Town Code", is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1-9-23, shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

1-9-23 Enforcement By Imprisonment: If a person is fined for violation of a municipal ordinance who is financially able but refuses or neglects to pay the fine or costs, or both, payment may be enforced by imprisonment, until same shall be satisfied, at the rate of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day or at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day for each day worked by prisoners toward fines or costs, or such person may be compelled to satisfy the amount owed by working on the streets, alleys, avenues, areas, and public grounds of the town, subject to the direction of a proper supervisor or officer, at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day for useful labor, until the fines or costs are satisfied.

SECTION 2.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE

An immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting, as required by law.
