

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA,
AMENDING SECTION 1-9-20(B.), CHAPTER 9, TITLE 1 OF THE
"CARNEGIE TOWN CODE"; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF
CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie, Oklahoma:

Section 1-9-20(B.), Chapter 9, Title 1 of the "Carnegie Town Code", is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1-9-20(B.), shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

1-9-20(B.) COURT COSTS: Court costs shall be in addition to any fine imposed and shall not exceed the sum of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per case plus the fees and mileage of witnesses as provided in subsection A of this section, subject to the limitations of 11 Oklahoma Statutes section 14-111(F) and any other limitations or exceptions imposed by law.

SECTION 2.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE

An immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting, as required by law.
